

EAFRD Project Update

Automated Flower Bunching Line

The aim of this project is to enable Poplar Farm Flowers Ltd to meet the increasing demand for high value cut and bunched flowers from multiple retailers. The investment will include the purchase of a state of the art flower bunching and packing line, which will increase the output of the existing processing system by a forecast of 50%.

Processing Line Automation

The project seeks to invest in the automation of the Emmet UK Ltd pack house to improve the efficiency, product flow and ultimately improve the product quality of the spinach and kale that is being washed, graded, weighed and bagged for the supermarkets. The proposed investments will involve automation of the pack house intake, tray handling and dispatch stacking operation.

New Brassica Facility

The project involves constructing a totally new facility to house four existing brassica processing lines. The aim is to increase efficiency and productivity of the business achieving a £1.7m increase in turnover and 7 new jobs over the next 5 years.

Doddington to Sustrans 64 Cycle Path Link

To construct a paved cycle path link between Doddington Hall and Sustrans Cycle path 64. This is a distance of 1600metres (1 mile) along an existing bridle path. This will create a safe and attractive 6 mile route from Doddington to the centre of Lincoln that will be used by local families and tourists as well as several of Doddington Farms LLP's 100 employees, who would cycle to work if a safe route was available.

Boston Bowl Activity Centre

The project is to provide new indoor/all- weather multi-themed activity centre for people from 3 years of age to adult, at Boston Bowl, Rochford Tower Lane, Boston, PE21 9RH. This project is located on the edge of Boston, and beneficiaries are likely to be rural.

Sprouts Business Growth

The project involves the installation of a new sprout grading, processing and packing line. The new sprout line is required to supply the increasing demand for sprout packs. This is a new and innovative grading and packing process using newly developed optical sorting technology, which will enable the business to sort to 4 key grades, optimise Class 1 sales and reduce waste. This project will improve the quality, productivity and competitiveness of the applicant's sprout business.

Track System Workshop and Track Store

This project involves the construction of a new steel building to house the manufacture of a newly developed IMTS tractor track systems and provide additional storage at Sutton St James near Spalding, enabling business growth and expansion.
