

Greater Lincolnshire Feasibility Fund Financial Year End Report 2016-17

Feasibility Pot

The feasibility pot was first launched in February 2016 to the value of £300,000. Commitments of £216,500 were initially made and it was agreed that the balance and an additional amount of £75,982 would be relaunched in October 2016. The total feasibility pot to date therefore is £375,982. To date 5 contract awards have been made. No claims for drawdown were received within 16/17 but we do expect to start making payments in the early part of 2017/18.
