#### Pubs, Restaurants and Cafes

Pubs, restaurants and cafes will be able to serve customers outdoors from 4<sup>th</sup> July in plans announced by the government in new information released.

#### Visit England

Visit England are rolling out the following support for tourism and hospitality sectors.

#### Stage 1 - Industry Standard

#### Stage 3 – Consumer Campaign activity

- VE are also adding a consumer facing campaign to support this; 'Know Before You Go'.
- The VE <u>Know Before you Go campaign</u> page includes an industry toolkit and assets for destinations and businesses to use in their marketing.
- VE will be using these in their national marketing from July onwards.

#### Sustainable Innovation Fund

Government has unveiled a £200m Sustainable Innovation Fund to help companies recovering from the impact of coronavirus (COVID-19) keep their cutting-edge projects and ideas alive.

#### **University and R&D Support**

Three support packages have been announced:-

- 1. The UK's research work plays a vital role in our economic prosperity but is at risk from a range of income losses as a result of coronavirus and so a support package for <u>university research and innovation</u> during coronavirus (COVID-19) has been launched.
- 2. <u>Two further packages</u> will give greater job protection to thousands of researchers, scientists and technicians working at UK universities during coronavirus (COVID-19).

#### **Food Sector**

#### Construction sector

Draft <u>guidance</u> sets out further detail on the proposed new route for applicants seeking to extend construction site working hours introduced in the Business and Planning Bill.

A series of documents and updates regarding the 2014 to 2020 European Structural and Investment Funds Programme and the response to COVID-19 have been responded to in a new <u>ERDF letter to partners</u> published on 26 June 2020 providing an update on the ERDF Programme response to COVID-19.
