Coronavirus Headlines

Workplace testing programme -REGISTRATION EXTENDED TO 12 APRIL FOR 10+ EMPLOYEES

All employers will now be able to offer their employees free, rapid and regular testing that can be taken at home. Government has now made rapid home testing available for all businesses with <u>over 10</u> employees who cannot offer on-site testing.

- Businesses must register interest by 12 April to access free tests
- Over 60,000 businesses already registered for regular and rapid tests for employees
- Programme extended to any business with over 10 employees

Changes from Monday 29 March

Some of the rules changed on 29 March. <u>Guidance</u> has been updated to include a summary of changes to the rules in England. From 29 March:

- You will be able to meet outdoors either in a group of 6 (from any number of households), or in a group of any size from up to 2 households (each household can include existing support bubbles, if eligible)
- You will be able to take part in formally organised outdoor sports with any number of people (outdoor sports venues and facilities will be able to reopen)
- Childcare and supervised activities will be allowed outdoors for all children

Reopening safely as Covid-19 restrictions are lifted

Read the <u>'COVID-19</u> <u>Response - Spring 2021'</u> for more information on the roadmap out of lockdown in England. Further settings are permitted to open to include outdoor sports facilities and formally organised outdoor sport. Indoor facilities, such as changing rooms, should not be used at this time, although toilet facilities can be accessed. Businesses eligible to host childcare and supervised activities for children will be able to host all outdoor children's activities, and outdoor parent -and child groups for up to 15 people (not counting those aged under five).

You must stay outside when meeting others to reduce the spread of Covid-19

The public are being reminded they must stay outside when meeting others as part of the next step of easing Covid restrictions in a new film released and narrated by GP Dr Hilary Jones MBE.

- From 29 March, groups of 6 people, or 2 households, are allowed to meet outside
- Scientists and medics are urging the public not to be tempted to meet indoors as the risk of spreading the virus is significantly higher inside
- Public urged 'Let's take this next step safely' in new campaign

Business and Economic Updates

Covid Restart Grant

The <u>Restart Grant</u> scheme supports businesses in the non-essential retail, hospitality, leisure, personal care, and accommodation sectors with a one-off grant, to reopen safely as Covid-19 restrictions are lifted. Grants available from 1 April 2021 but applications can be submitted in advance.

Geographical transition for businesses

The support that businesses in North and North East Lincolnshire will be moving to the Business Lincolnshire Growth Hub this week from 1st April 2021.

The geographical overlap between the Greater Lincolnshire LEP and the Humber LEP is being removed. From 1st April 2021 North and North East Lincolnshire will be part of the Greater Lincolnshire LEP only and no longer part of the Humber LEP. The advice and support for businesses will not change and in the majority of cases the existing business advisors will remain the same and we will advise where contacts do change. The current European Regional Development Fund programmes will continue to be delivered until the funding ends in June 2023.

Working safely during Covid-19

<u>Guidance</u> has been updated with a new shorter format focusing on actions to make the workplace Covid-secure and Step 1 of the roadmap out of lockdown.

Restrictions on entering the Netherlands

From Tuesday 16 March, freight drivers do not need to take a coronavirus test if you are an HGV or van driver returning to the Netherlands after spending less than 48 hours in the UK. <u>Guidance</u> has been updated to include information on Covid-19 test timeframes for round-trips between the UK and the Netherlands.

Suspension of Trade Operations at Manston, Kent

From Sunday 21 March, all haulier processing operations, including Covid testing for hauliers, has been suspended at Manston Airport. If heading to the Port of Dover or Eurotunnel, drivers will be directed straight onto the M20. Free Covid testing for hauliers is still available at one of the many <u>Information</u> and Advice sites, and Inland Border Facility checks will continue to be processed by Ashford Sevington, or one of the other sites <u>across the country</u>. Hauliers are strongly encouraged to get a negative Covid-19 test, to use the Check an HGV is Ready to Cross the Border service and get a valid Kent Access Permit before arriving in Kent to minimise delays. Please also follow any traffic management signs.

Education, Employment & Skills

Education inspections in the summer term

Ofsted will inspect schools and further education & skills (FES) providers in the summer term to provide reassurance about how well children and learners are catching up, but it will not resume a full programme of graded inspections until September. Following extensive discussion with government and education leaders, Ofsted has confirmed that it will undertake on-site, lighter-touch inspections in the summer term and unlike full inspections, these visits will allow inspectors to assess how well

schools and FES providers are educating their learners and keeping them safe, but they will not result in a grade. **Read f**urther info <u>here.</u>
