People urged to contact GP practice with up to date contact details

As the rollout of the Covid-19 vaccination programme continues at pace across Lincolnshire, under 40s are being asked to contact their GP practice if their address or mobile number has changed recently, so to ensure practices have the correct information.

Vaccination appointments now available in Grantham via the National Booking Service

Appointments for Covid-19 vaccinations are now available on the National Booking Service for people who live in Grantham, Sleaford and surrounding areas, to attend the Local Vaccination Centre (LVC) at the Table Tennis Club, Meres Leisure Centre, Grantham (Trent Road NG31 7XQ).

This is for people who are eligible, including anyone who is 38 or over, and there are appointments available for next week at the Meres LVC that can be booked online <u>here</u>.

More than 20 million UK adults receive both doses of COVID-19 vaccine

More than 36 million people in the UK have been vaccinated with 1 dose of the vaccine, and 20 million have received 2 doses as the vaccine programme continues to progress at pace. The public are being urged to take up their second dose as soon as they are eligible in order to get fullest possible protection. Further information can be found <u>here</u>.

Working from home? Claim tax relief in 2021 to 2022

More than half a million people have claimed the working from home tax relief this tax year and are already benefitting. HM Revenue and Customs (HMRC) is accepting tax relief claims for working from home due to coronavirus during 2021 to 2022. More than 550,000 employed workers have already claimed and are benefitting from the tax relief. Further information can be found <u>here</u>.

EU VAT Changes

This interactive masterclass will be delivered online in response to numerous enquiries from East Midlands businesses regarding the EU VAT eCommerce package coming into effect from 1st July. DIT East Midlands and EU VAT specialist Ellen Main Jeffrey from <u>JustVAT</u> will be on hand to offer insight and answer your questions.

The EU has been looking at ways to streamline VAT accounting for both EU VAT registered businesses and non-EU businesses selling into the EU and make it easier for individual sellers to report VAT and from 1st July 2021, the EU VAT eCommerce Package will launch. This means that B2C eCommerce sellers and eMarketplaces will face new VAT obligation reforms initiated by the 27 member states of the European Union.
