Coronavirus Headlines

60 million doses of COVID-19 vaccine administered in UK

Over 60 million doses of the COVID-19 vaccine have been administered, with 37.9 million people in the UK receiving at least one jab and more than 22.6 million people receiving both doses. Further information available here.

Vaccines highly effective against new variant after 2 doses

A new study by PHE shows for the first time that two doses of the COVID-19 vaccine are highly effective against the B.1.617.2 variant first identified in India, and expect to see even higher levels of effectiveness against hospitalisation and death. Further information available here.

This survey asks Lincolnshire businesses how the past 3 months compare to the previous period - covering aspects such as sales and orders, workforce cashflow, and confidence.

Greater Lincolnshire LEP latest intelligence roundup headlines

Latest statistics on the claimant count* show that the number of people claiming across Greater Lincolnshire inc. Rutland in April 2021 has decreased slightly by 2.8% compared to the previous month. Across the UK, the claimant count also decreased by 1.7% over the same period.

Latest job vacancy data has shown a large increase in vacancies in *transport and logistics*, which rose by 20 percentage points to 254% of its February 2020 average level. This is a continuation of a strong upward trend for this category, having increased since February this year. This is also the highest volume of online job adverts seen for this category since the beginning of the series in February 2018.

*(an experimental series that counts the number of people claiming Jobseeker's Allowance plus those who claim Universal Credit and are required to seek work and be available for work)

Boasting 3 co-ordinators in the team, match funded by the LEP and LCC, we have a movement of 62 private and public sector leaders who are volunteer Enterprise Advisers who provide peer support and challenge on careers education locally in schools and colleges.

EU Transition

EU Settlement Scheme - Deadline end of June!

The Home Office is advising businesses that the deadline of 30 June 2021 for applications is nearing to be made to the EU Settlement Scheme (EUSS).

It is therefore important that all businesses check with their EU, EEA and Swiss employees who were resident in the UK by 31 December 2020, to make sure that they have already applied or will do so before the deadline so that this doesn't impact on staffing. The Greater Lincolnshire LEP Online Jobs and Careers Fair Series

Since its inception in November 2020, the Greater Lincolnshire Online Jobs Fair series has welcomed nearly 5,000 visitors to the live events, and over 150 exhibitors (a mixture of local employers, education and training providers and support services). May's event was the 7th live fair in the series, and was hosted by Karl McCartney, MP for Lincoln. Highlights included:

- Over 200 individuals visiting the site in 3 hours, with nearly 100 person to person engagements taking place via instant chat and video call.
- 73 exhibitors taking part, with 59 employers actively advertising multiple job vacancies
- Strong representation from across sectors and industries, including Health and Care, Manufacturing and Engineering, and the Visitor Economy.
