AstraZeneca Covid vaccination walk-in appointments available at PRSA Boston and the Lincolnshire Showground

The county's two Mass Vaccination Centres (MVCs) at PRSA, Boston, and the Lincolnshire Showground will be offering walk-in AstraZeneca Covid-19 vaccinations in the week commencing 21st June.

Those aged 40 years or over will be able to attend for a first dose vaccination or a second dose if there is a minimum eight week gap since their first dose. Available on a 'first come, first served' basis, the walk-ins will be using AstraZeneca only and will be available as follows:

- PRSA MVC, Boston: Monday 21st -Thursday 24th June, 8am - 7pm
- Lincolnshire Showground MVC: Monday
 21st Thursday 24th June, 8am 7pm

Walk-in sessions are expected to be busy so please remain patient. There is no requirement to be registered with a GP or to have an NHS number to attend.
