5. Latest information for farmers, landowners and rural businesses during the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak

The Rural Payments helpline - 03000 200 301 - will be open on Saturday 13 June and Sunday 14 June from 8.30am to 2pm. This is to support customers leading up to the 15 June deadline for Basic Payment Scheme (BPS) applications, and Countryside Stewardship (CS) and Environmental Stewardship (ES) annual revenue claims. 6. Discretionary Grant Fund

• The DGF supports_small and micro businesses that are not eligible for other grant schemes. Eligibility points confirmed include (1) your business should have on-going fixed property-related costs, and (2)

occupy property (or part of a property) with a rateable value or annual mortgage/rent payments below £51,000. Full details on the fund can be found <u>here.</u>

7. Hoteliers and accommodation providers

8. Childcare services
